Responsibilities – The ideal candidate possesses achievement in all the following:

- Ownership for adherence to Company Environmental Health Safety and Quality Standards (EHSQ).
- Continuously changing facility and employee culture through creative training, and adherence to safety policies and program.
- Reduces the occurrence of recordable injuries and illnesses, OII incident rates and recordable group rates (insurance related).
- Reduces the occurrence of lost time injuries (or maintains at zero).
- Ensures all safety and maintenance inspections, forms, and meetings are completed on time and as required.
- Enforces Company and Union EHS agreement to ensure compliance and retribution.
- Provides information for budgeting purposes (project cost, labor and material cost, etc.) and reviews operational budgets.
- Implements modern solutions and techniques for obstacles which may prevent targeted EHS compliances.

Requirements – in addition to the above, top candidates possess:

- Bachelor in Industrial Health and Safety (or equivalent);
- Technical experience within a manufacturing environment preferred;
- Effective communicator at all levels of an environment;
- Hands-on and results-oriented; and
- Able to work indoors and outdoors with some physical activity required.
